I recently wrote a letter to the Grand Aerie about some ongoing issues we have had with some of our members not following the rules. After several discussions, the Grand Aerie sent out Mr. Dan Thompson, the Pacific Northwest Regional Aerie Advisor. Mr. Thompson came to the Aerie on September 16. While here he checked our record books, finances, insurance, and compliance as per the Yearly Grand Aerie Survey. We passed the evaluation in all areas with high marks. This is a testament to the hard work that our Aerie Officers do each week.

After our evaluation, Mr Thompson met with our Officers to discuss the issues that we have brought up to the Grand Aerie about ongoing problems with members not following the rules of the Grand Aerie, By-Laws, and House Rules. In the afternoon he met with members of both the Aerie and Auxiliary to hear their issues and concerns. In the evening, Mr Thompson then joined us for the regular Aerie meeting. His report at the meeting was that he hoped that he had explained, informed, and dispelled several issues related to the rules of the Grand Aerie. He hopes that things will go smoother in the future, but pointed out that if members continue to not follow the rules then the next step should be suspension.
